**VARIETY FEATURES**

- Lavender-blue, star-shaped flowers with white centers in summer and autumn
- vigorous and trailing

**TRANSPLANT LINERS**

**POT SIZE:** Transplant liners into quart (1 liter), 6-inch (15 cm) or standard 1-gallon (4 liter) pot with one cell per pot.

**MEDIA:** Porous soil with good drainage.

**VERNALIZATION:** Not required for flowering.

**FINISHING & SCHEDULING**

**MEDIA pH:** 5.5 to 6.5.

**MEDIA EC:** 1.5 to 2 for 1-gallon (4 liter) pot.

**MOISTURE:** Requires well-drained soil; do not keep too wet.

**FERTILIZER:** While actively growing, plants perform well with a constant liquid feed of 100 to 150 ppm nitrogen.

**SUPPLEMENTAL LIGHTING:** Long days are required for flowering.

**TEMPERATURE:** 55° to 60°F (13° to 16°C) night temperature and 65° to 75°F (18° to 24°C) day temperature for optimum growth. Do not tolerate high heat and humidity.

**COMMON PESTS:** Thrips.

**COMMON DISEASES:** Botrytis, Colletotrichum.

**Pinching:** Not necessary.

**CROP MAINTENANCE:** Cut back flower stems after flowering to encourage more blooms.

**GROWTH REGULATORS:** Not necessary.

**SCHEDULING RECOMMENDATIONS:** Plant in March or April from unvernallized liners for flowering pots in June.
