TRANSPLANT LINERS

Transplant: Plant unvernalized liners in final sales container in the fall of previous year. Allow bulking up before placing outside for over wintering or in a cold greenhouse heated to 35°F (2°C). If over wintering outdoors, covering with a frost blanket is recommended. Allow plants to flower in their natural season starting in June.

Pot Size: 1 Gallon (4 liter) pot.

FINISHING & SCHEDULING

Media pH: 5.5-6.5

Moisture: Keep evenly moist. Do not allow to dry out.

Fertilizer: While actively growing, plants perform well with a constant liquid feed of 150 ppm nitrogen. Do not allow salts to build up or Pythium can be an issue.

Growth Regulators: Not required.

Temperature: 60° to 65°F (16° to 18°C)

Supplemental Lighting: Not required.

Common Pests: Aphids, red spider.

Common Diseases: Mildews, Pythium.

Finishing: 8-10 weeks.

Flowering: Allow plants to flower in their natural season starting in June.
