Leucanthemum SUNSHINE FREAK!™

UNROOTED CUTTINGS

Upon Arrival: If necessary to store, keep in a cooler at 41-45° F

Rooting Hormone: 500 ppm IBA

Soil Temperature: 70°F

Fertilization: Begin fertilizing once roots appear with a low rate

of 50 to 100 ppm nitrogen.

Mist: Low to Moderate, do not let sit wet. 2-3 weeks in

propagation, and 3-4 weeks to finish a liner.

TRANSPLANT LINERS

Pot Size: Transplant liners into 1-gallon (4 liter) pot, one plant

per pot.

Media: Porous soil with good drainage.

Vernalization: Not required.

FINISHING & SCHEDULING

Media pH: 5.8-6.2

Moisture: Grow evenly moist, do not let sit wet. **Fertilizer:** Constant feed at 150-200 ppm N.

Growth Regulators: Not necessary.

Temperature: 55-65 °F nights & 65-70°F days.

Common Pests: Aphids

Common Diseases: Crown rot due to excessive winter wetness. **Finishing:** Plant unvernalized liners outdoors in April or May and plants will start flowering in about 7 to 9 weeks after transplant.
