Verbena bonariensis 'Lollipop'

UNROOTED CUTTINGS

Upon Arrival: If necessary to store, keep in a cooler at 41-45° F

Air Temperature: 70°F

Fertilization: Begin fertilizing once roots appear with a low rate

of 50 to 100 ppm nitrogen.

Mist: Moderately low mist, do not allow to over saturate. 2-3

weeks in propagation, and 3-4 weeks to finish a liner.

Pinch: Pinch for best branching.

TRANSPLANT LINERS

Transplant: Liners in the Spring 1 plant per pot.

Pot Size: Quart or 1 gallon pots.

MEDIA: Porous soil with good drainage.

FINISHING & SCHEDULING

Media pH: 5.5-6.5

Moisture: Grow evenly moist, and do not keep too wet.

Fertilizer: Constant feed at 200-250 ppm N.

Growth Regulators: Not required.

Temperature: 60°F (16°C) night temperature and 65° to 75°F

(18° to 24°C) day temperature for optimum growth.

Supplemental Lighting: Long days are beneficial for flowering.

Common Pests: Thrips, whitefly. **Common Diseases:** Powdery mildew.

Finishing: 6 -8 weeks

Flowering: Starts in May and blooms through to frost.
