

The long green leaves are heavily mottled purple toward the center, which fades as the growth matures. Long, horizontally held, branched flower spikes that exceed 15" long. Each flower is composed of a light yellow outer spur, a darker yellow inner spur, and a faint touch of brown. Epimedium 'Spring Sunrise' is sure to be a standout in the spring garden.
