Originally founded under the name Blooms of Bressingham, Must Have Perennials® has been providing exceptional quality perennials for over 35 years. The Blooms organization has its roots as a nursery in the UK, founded in 1926 under the same namesake by Alan Bloom. As an organization geared towards representing and supporting breeders, Blooms was able to attract some of the best talent in the industry, focusing almost exclusively on garden-performance perennials. Alan and his son, Adrian, have helped bring hundreds of varieties to market over the years, including such Must Have Perennials favorites as: Geranium Rozanne®, Polemonium Brise d' Anjou, and Achillea Moonshine. These varieties, along with countless others, helped position Blooms of Bressingham as a leading provider of genetics to the perennial industry.

In the early part of the 2000's, the organization was purchased by Aris Horticulture and went through a rebranding, subsequently adopting the name Must Have Perennials®. Operating out of Green Leaf Plants in Lancaster, PA; the organization continued it's legacy of trialing material from breeders around the world and introducing exceptional perennials to the larger horticulture market. Through social media and other marketing channels, the organization became actively engaged with a growing online audience, continually providing helpful information for cultivating and promoting perennials varieties throughout the world.

In early 2025, the organization was purchased by the Ball Horticultural Company; located in West Chicago, IL. Under new leadership from Ball, Must Have Perennials continues to seek out the most exceptional plant material the industry has to offer.

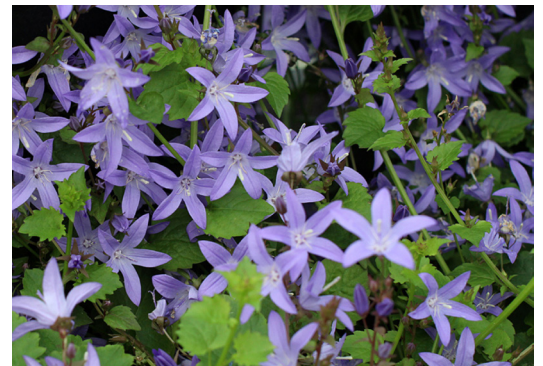
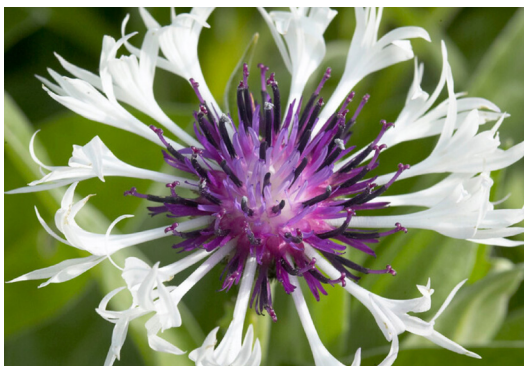
In the summer of 1975, Paul Gooderham went to work at Bressingham Gardens under the leadership of Alan Bloom. Having grown up around the horticulture industry, Paul's grandfather had worked with Alan after World War II, helping breed and introduce some of the most notable perennials to ever grace the world of horticulture; including Sedum 'Autumn Joy' and Achillea 'Moonshine'. Unbeknownst to Paul, this first job at Bressingham would launch him into a lifelong career in horticulture, let alone a 50-year career trialing and introducing plants within the Blooms network.

During his tenure with the organization, Paul helped to introduce numerous perennials with the help of Adrian Bloom; son of Alan Bloom, whom subsequently founded the company, Blooms of Bressingham. This has included the Achillea Tutti Frutti series, Centaurea 'Amethyst in Snow', Campanula 'Blue Waterfall', and countless others. While all of these varieties were great additions to the perennial offering throughout the world, none of them would have as much impact as his most famous introduction, Geranium Rozanne ('gerwat').

Bred by the Waterer's in the 1990's, Paul immediately saw the potential in this novel geranium and helped bring this exceptional plant to market, launching what would become the RHS Plant of the Centenary.

This year, we bid farewell to Paul and thank him for his years of service; as well as his indelible impact on the world of horticulture.
